EVENT AND STATUS:

The event will be known, as the **COOPERTIRES 4X4 CHALLENGE** and will be held at the 4x4 track at DIRT AND DUST, DURBANVILLE.

DESCRIPTION:

- 4.1 The route will consist of minimum 10 obstacles for four-wheel drive vehicles and class D.
- 4.2 The event will start at 09:00 on 17 August 2019. Competitors must report to the start official at the starting line of each obstacle when called upon to do so. Failure to comply with this within 2 minutes will lead to exclusion.

ELIGIBILITY AND PRE-START REQUIREMENTS:

6.1 Competitors

All Competitors (drivers and co-drivers) must be in possession of a minimum of a MSA Social Competition License valid for 4x4.

All licences must be done online before the event via www.msaonline.co.za. Competitors will not be allowed to compete if he / she cannot produce a valid MSA licence.

The cost of a One Event Social License is R115-00 per person (both driver and codriver must have a license).

The cost of the MSA Group Accident Cover is R343-00 per person if the competitor does not have his / her own medical cover while competing in Motorsport events. Proof of medical cover must be submitted with the licence (both Driver and Codriver must have medical cover).

6.2 Vehicles

Refer to the 2019 Cape 4x4 Challenge Club Regulations (161930/144).

6.3 Advertising

Competitors' attention is drawn to GCR 246(iii), which makes it a condition of entry to display sponsors' advertising material supplied by the Organizers. Refer also to GCR 247.

6.4 Acquaintance with and Submission to the Rules

Competitors' attention is drawn to GCR 122.

CLASSES:

Vehicles will be divided into the classes as defined in the Cape 4X4 Challenge Club Regulations and Specifications. Depending on entries, the Fun class and CL-class might be spilt into sub classes.

ENTRIES:

8.1 General

Entries open immediately and **close on 14 August 2019 18H00**, by which time properly completed entry forms accompanied by the prescribed fee must be in the hands of the Organizers. Entries not accompanied by the relevant fee (or proof of deposit thereof in the bank account) will not be accepted and will be returned to the entrant.

Should a competitor be uncertain whether he would be able to compete, he should nevertheless submit an entry, together with the prescribed entry fee. Should he then be unable to compete, he should inform the Organizers in writing by no later than 17:00 on 14 August 2019. If the Organizers are in receipt of such a withdrawal of entry, they will refund the entry fee less an R50.00 handling fee to the entrant.

EVENT HEADQUARTERS AND OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD:

10.1 Event Headquarters

Event Headquarters will be situated at the 4x4 track at Dirt and Dust from the start of the event to the finish of the event.

10.2 Official Notice Board

The Official Notice Board will be situated at the Dirt and Dust Track for the duration of the event. Competitors are requested to read any Final instructions posted on the official notice board before the event.

Competitors are requested to check the notice board periodically.

DOCUMENTATION:

Documentation will take place at the Cape 4x4 Challenge Club caravan from 06:00 to 08:15.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering will take place in Parc Ferme from 06:00 to 08:15.

IMPOUND AND PARC FERME:

- 14.1 Competitors will be required to impound their vehicles on completing of Scrutineering.
- 14.2 Competitors are requested not to leave the terrain until everyone has completed the event. Unless signed off by the COC.
- 14.3 To be parked in Parc Ferme, please refer to the Cape 4x4 Challenge Club Regulations point 23.2

DRIVING CONDUCT:

This type of competition is not a speed event. The Clerk of the Course may exclude any competitor who, in his opinion, is driving too fast or recklessly in an obstacle or transport section. No passengers other than the crew of the vehicle or officials will be allowed on any competing vehicle during the time of the event.

EXCLUSION:

Refer to point 22 of the C4x4CC Challenge Club Regulations. In addition to the exclusions specified in the rules, the following will apply for this event:

- Failing to start and/or remain in the correct starting position.

RESULTS:

- 17.1 Provisional results will be posted at the Prize giving on Saturday, 17 August 2019. Subject to no protests being received in terms of GCR 200, these results will become final 30 minutes later.
- 17.2 Competitors' attention is drawn to Parts IX and X and Appendix "R" of the MSA Handbook for protests and appeals.
- 17.3 Should there be an unforeseen delay in announcing the results; the Stewards of the Meeting may postpone such announcement. Refer to GCR 280(ii).

PRIZE GIVING:

Prize giving will commence at 18:30 on Saturday, 17 August 2019, subject to no protests being received.

AWARDS:

- 19.1 All awards will be presented to the crew of the vehicle unless the entrant claims the award in writing upon entering the event. Refer to GCR 281(i).
- 19.2 All awards will be distributed at Prize giving.
- 19.3 Trophies will be awarded to the drivers, co-drivers placed first, second, and third for all classes.

RIGHTS OF THE CLERK OF THE COURSE - PROMOTERS AND ORGANIZERS:

20.1 The Clerk of the Course reserves the right (subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meeting) to:

- a) Alter the departure times and route if forced to do so through weather conditions or for any other reasons;
- b) Alter the starting and scoring methods, if it is found necessary to do so.

20.2 The Promoters/Organizers reserve the right (subject to the approval of MSA) to:

- a) Postpone abandon or cancel the event if fewer than ten paid entries are received by the time and date of entries closing. Refer to GCR 99(v);
- b) Refuse any entry. Refer to GCR's 99 (i) and 100.
